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Comfort Cap Instructions

Supplies

Adult - 1/2 yard of knit

Child - 1/3 yard of knit (Most women fit in a child's size large)

Polyester sewing thread

Sewing scissors

Fabric marking pencil, pen, or chalk

Pins

Directions:

1. Copy the adult or child's cap pattern off on your computer's printer.
2. Place the pattern on the fabric using the "stretch" line as your guide across the stretchiest part of your fabric. Cut two pieces, one for the cap and one for the lining. Transfer all the markings to the fabric. If possible, reduce the presser foot pressure on your machine to prevent rippling when sewing on knits.
3. Sew the outside darts first starting at the edge and sewing to the dot right sides together. See figures 1 and 2
4. With right sides together, match the seam lines of the 2 darts. Line up the edges of the center back seam. Sew up the center back seam and down into the center dart to the dot. See figure 3
- Repeat steps 3 and 4 for the lining.
6. Place the two hats inside each other, right sides together, matching the seam lines and center fronts. Match the brim edges and pin. Stitch leaving a 3" opening for turning.
7. Turn the hat to the right side and turn the open edge in. Top-stitch around the edge 1/8" in from the edge.

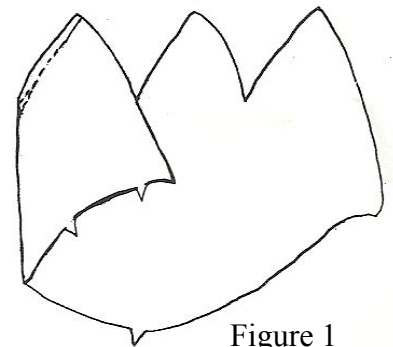

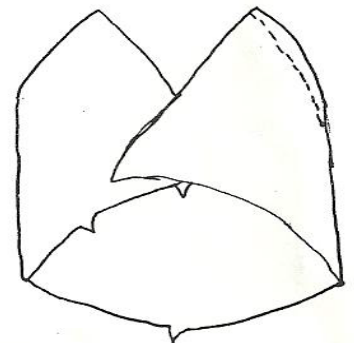

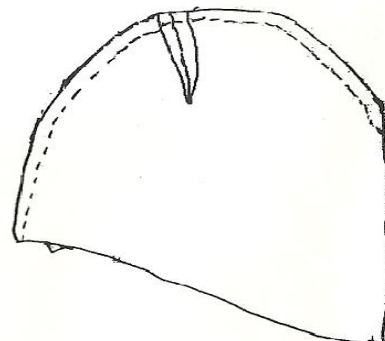
